

CROSSWALK for CERTIFICATES, EXAMINATIONS, and LICENSES

At Central Maine Community College, a student may qualify to receive academic credit for a specific course by presenting proof of a current and valid professional credential designed to assess the student's knowledge in a field. Credential review is subject to applicability to the student's program of study. Eligibility: Students must be registered, matriculated at CMCC. Bring original, current, valid credentials to the Registrar's Office. Official transcripts may be required.
