An associate degree or higher in Occupational Safety and Health or a related field is required. Requirements to teach OHS 111 or OHS 115 include completion of OSHA #500 and #510 courses; requirements to teach OHS 102 include completion of OSHA #501 and #511. Possession of an authorized outreach trainer card is required and must be provided by 8/1/19.
