MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:	<p>An Associate Degree is required along with performed work experience in general maintenance and equipment repair providing proven knowledge of carpentry, masonry, electrical, welding, plumbing, painting, mechanical and grounds care and established OSHA, EPA and DEP standards and regulations. Supervisory experience overseeing workers performing building custodial tasks, as well as those performing general maintenance and repair work is also required. Proven excellent written and oral communication skills are required, and a valid Maine driver's license is also required. HVAC knowledge and a Class A license are preferred. Experience working with boilers, heating and water systems would be helpful.</p>
RESPONSIBILITIES:	<p>This working, supervisory position works under limited supervision and is responsible for performing and participating in the planning of various work projects and details and equipment maintenance in and around the College to include maintenance and repair of College owned equipment such as HVAC, plumbing systems and equipment; light and heavy-duty maintenance machinery such as dump trucks and yard tractors, as well as performing duties related to snow and ice removal, lawn care, as well as special event planning, etc. The Facilities Maintenance Supervisor also supervises the work of building custodians and student workers alongside and in the absence of the Facilities Manager.</p>
