PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS

- 18 years of age;
- High school diploma, GED, or HiSet
- U.S. Citizenship and/or authorization to work in the U.S.

To be employed in this field, candidates will need to have a criminal background check and up-to-date immunization records.
