The Associate in Science in Education prepares students for transfer to bachelor's degree programs to become education technicians, certified teachers, or to provide continuing education in preK-12 education school settings to professional teachers.

Students in this program will plan learning opportunities that support an individual's physical, cognitive, and social/emotional development. A variety of instructional strategies are emphasized to meet diverse learning needs and encourage critical thinking and problem solving.

Graduates may earn additional credentials with our Education Advanced Certificate if they choose to pursue an Education III certificate with the state.

Graduates who complete a bachelor's degree may be employed as:

- Education Technician
- Certified Teachers
- Teach continuing education to certified teachers in PreK – 12 education school settings
