This position measures program effectiveness; prepares data for and contributes to preparation of a variety of reports for internal and external partners; assures data accuracy and improves data integrity in processes across the college; develops and conducts survey research in response to institutional needs; provides training and data support to key college leaders; responds to ad hoc requests for information; and completes federal, state and institutional reports. The position performs other research and planning duties as assigned.

- Associate's Degree in a related field.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite and student information systems, preferably Jenzabar, familiarity with, or willingness to learn, SQL.
- Ability to meet deadlines and work under pressure.
