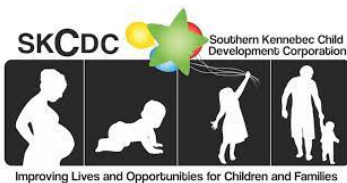

Participants who complete this certification program may have six credits applied toward an Associate in Applied Science in Early Childhood Education at Central Maine Community College.
