Title of Position: Physical Fitness/Exercise Science Instructor

Bargaining Unit / Salary Range: Salary and Benefits commensurate with the Agreement between the MCCS Trustees and the MEA Faculty Unit. This position is budgeted at \$48,836.30.

RESPONSIBILITIES: This full-time faculty position includes teaching responsibilities in the Physical Fitness Specialist Program and Exercise Science Program starting with the Spring 2022 semester. The instructor will be expected to teach a combination of lecture and laboratory classes, provide student advising, develop curriculum and conduct assessment for current and new courses. Courses are offered on-ground and online.

Proof of Covid-19 vaccination will be required prior to the first day of employment.

- Master's degree in Sport Psychology, Exercise Physiology, Exercise Science, Kinesiology or closely related field
- Experience teaching exercise science, exercise training, rehabilitation and exercise, fitness, or related area at the college level.
