**Position: Nursing Faculty**

**SUMMARY**

This full-time faculty position begins with the Fall 2022 Semester. In addition to regular teaching duties, this position will provide oversight and management of the clinical activities of adjunct clinical faculty and act as advisor to full-time faculty, serving as a support and resource. This position will provide orientation to clinical faculty, working with clinical faculty at the site to consult on instruction and supervision of nursing students. This position is a liaison between the clinical site and the nursing department in support of the student educational experience. Proof of up-to-date COVID-19 vaccination required prior to employment.
