**SUMMARY**

This full-time faculty position begins with the Fall 2022 Semester. In addition to regular teaching duties, this position will coordinate the nursing skills and simulation laboratory activities at all nursing sites, support part-time faculty in all lab/simulation activities and maintain and order equipment and supplies. This position will provide student advising and participate in assigned committees, assist with lab budget, develop, maintain, administer and analyze data to demonstrate the effectiveness for the simulation lab and work with other nursing faculty to develop and use simulation.
