ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following, however, other duties may be assigned.

The Director of Information Security and Infrastructure is responsible for all areas of networking, information security, and technology infrastructure at CMCC. The Director assists and develops network, security strategy, policy, and implementation of best practices. This position also requires an understanding of information security management systems and standards; extensive project management experience; and internal IT security auditing experience. An aptitude to research and identify emerging standards, products and security issues and solutions as well as a solid understanding of IT systems, administration and network engineering is essential. This position reports to the Dean of Information Technology.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's Degree in computer science or related field. Equivalent experience may be substituted for education on a year-to-year basis
- 2-4 years of relative work experience
- Experience with IT network engineering, virtualization, and systems administration.
- Knowledge and understanding of current and developing information technology security practices, procedures and policies and the ability to stay abreast of new security sector developments
- CompTIA Security+ and CISSP certifications or other globally recognized cybersecurity certification
- Proof of COVID-19 vaccination will be required prior to first day of employment, subject to exemptions recognized by law.
