Students in this program are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor and the Director of Placement and Transfer Services to plan a course of study that meets their educational goals.

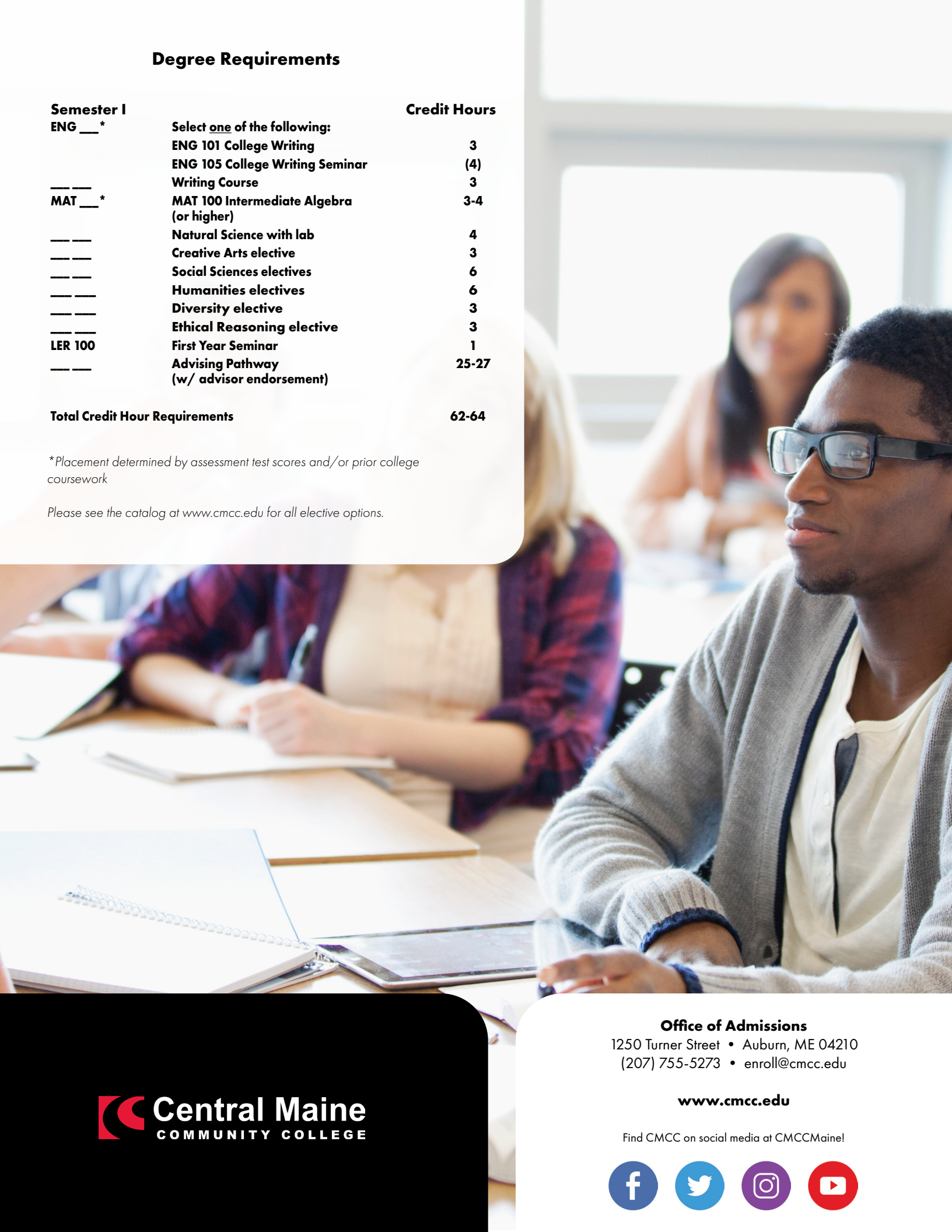
