Incoming credit from MRTQ to CMCC

The student must:

- Be awarded the MRTQ Professional Development Network (PDN) State of Maine Approved Infant Toddler Credential.
- Submit a certificate of completion for the state approved credential to CMCC Education Department Chair: Tia Zukowski (tzukowski@maineccc.edu).
- The certificate must include the awardee's name, title of credential, award date, and MRTQ PDN official's signature.

Outgoing credit from CMCC to MRTQ

The student must:

- Have been enrolled at CMCC and accepted into the Early Childhood Education program and have earned no less than a C in the identified courses.
- Submit a transcript from CMCC to MRTQ-PDN.
- Work with the Credential team at MRTQ-PDN to plan for successful credential completion. This includes submission of an application, portfolio, and an onsite observation and family surveys.

Awarding of the State-Approved Maine Infant Toddler Credential will be dependent on the student's successful completion of the following.

- Successful completion of the Portfolio.
- Satisfactory completion of the Maine Infant Toddler Credential On-Site Observation.
- A return rate of 75%, with an 80% positive rating on the Maine Infant Toddler Credential Family Surveys.
